



ERIC JOHN FORBES, or John as he was known to us all, was born in South Africa in 1961. He didn't speak much of his early upbringing as there were many lows, but there were also times of love and laughter, and in recent years he enjoyed the renewed contact with his family, visiting them in South Africa on a few occasions.

His family was involved in Rhodesian Ridgebacks and German Shepherds in the early 50's and his love of dogs was evident to all from an early age.



He immigrated to Australia in 1972 and wasn't long without a dog, buying the first of his many canine companions that year. It might seem strange to imagine him with an Old English Sheepdog, but that was his first Australian show dog whom he showed throughout 1973.

In the same year he 'inherited' a Basenji boy – this was the start of his long association and love of the Basenji breed.

In the mid 1970's John approached Marie Dymock of Africa Kennels – he was after a bitch of quality that he could found his Baagna Kennels with. He initially purchased Ch Afrika April Showers and then her daughter, Ch Afrika Cexe Cindy, and John always said that these two bitches provided the backbone for his success.

Throughout the years Baagna dogs and bitches have been well represented in the winner's circle. He had many wins with his dogs and was always proud to do well under 'Basenji specialist judges'. He was extremely proud of Ch Baagna Justa Fella, who won six Best in Show awards including All Breeds, Hound and Speciality shows and the prestigious Canberra Royal in 1988. Supreme Ch Baagna Alpha Cheek was also a stand out in the All Breeds ring, with many awards and achievements. His dogs are also well represented as Sire of the Day at the NSW Championship shows, and many kennels have been founded on either one of his stock or by using a Baagna Boy. John bred over 120 champions and exported stock to many countries.

John also supported another popular activity with Basenji owners throughout the late seventies and eighty's – that of racing, and was tickled pink that Ch Baagna Erastus 'Brutus', (owned by Deidre Jones) a multiple BIS winner, was also an outstanding performer in the field and attained a Grand Champion Racing title. Not to be outdone, Ch Baagna Lyka Lover (owned by Reg Dwyer) attained his obedience title of Companion Dog – no mean feat for a Basenji!

John held many positions in his 40 years with the NSW Basenji Club, most importantly that of Treasurer and President for multiple terms. It was in 1989 under the guidance of John, that the NSW club took the important step of becoming incorporated which was finally achieved in 1991. John was a keen supporter of the club and always attended as many meetings as possible. He also assisted with many other club activities, such as breed displays and pet expos – carting breed paraphernalia and set designs to many locations. in Dogs NSW participating in many committees, especially judges training, and he served as Vice Chairman of Dogs NSW Board of Directors in 2007. He currently held 6 treasurer positions for clubs at this time, and I know he will be hard for clubs to find a replacement.

John commenced his judges training in 1982 and achieved All Breed status in 2005. He judged in many countries, was honoured to officiate at many specialities, and always enjoyed the challenge of 'finding the best dog'. He didn't travel as extensively as he wished, as with a kennel of dogs it was difficult to arrange. Once he retired he hoped to travel more extensively but alas, this was not to be.


I could go on and on with stories about John, but I feel the most important thing to say was that he was a gentleman and a friend. Some may say that he was one eyed and dogmatic, but he certainly believed in his dogs and tried to uphold a very high standard. I enjoyed many a long discussion with him over a glass or two, but mostly over the phone. We agreed on some things and agreed to disagree on others, but he always respected what you had to say and if you asked for his opinion on a dog, he would give it. In later years he tempered this with "Are you sure you want my opinion?", but he would always help anyone who asked.

It has been very hard to write these words, but I hope that I have given you an overview of John's life and, if by chance I have misconstrued anything, then it is my fault alone.

Parades, Open Shows and Puppy picnics held at the country estate of John's (in the words of a past editor) "Horsley Park" saw many get togethers of Basenji folk. Bev Foye, Di Brooks and John hosted many social events and also provided overnight accommodation to interstate visitors for the annual Basenji Championship show. These events were a training ground for many new Basenji owners and were well known for their convivial and social aspects, as well as the serious business of evaluating and training the dogs. After John moved to Londonderry, the practice of open house for interstate visitors continued. He and Ida Bell loved entertaining and many an after show dinner continued on around the table with a bottle or two of port.

He was keenly interested in the promotion of junior members of the dog world and worked tirelessly encouraging and mentoring any junior who requested help. He was instrumental in the formation of the Junior Kennel Club, and supported it right until the end. John was also heavily involved We shouldn't feel sad that John's life has ended. He led a full and happy life right till the end, determined to battle on and be actively involved in the hobby he loved.



Ross and I purchased our first basenji, Ch Biafra Nyuma, in 1973 and thus began a 43 year association with our beloved breed.

Under the Jebelmarra prefix we began a long line of breeding, from lines that stretched back to Veronica Tudor-Williams famous import, Fula of the Congo. We succeeded, in the ensuing years, in producing exhibits that took centre stage at Specialties and, on occasions, at The Sydney Royal Easter Show.

I began my Hound Group judging in 1980 and had the thrill of my first appointment with the Basenji Club of NSW Easter Parade. Over the years since then, I qualified as an all-breeds judge in 2003, and I have judged many breeds, in many countries, around the world.

My husband, Ron, and I obtained our first Basenji in 1970 and bred under the "Makuba" prefix with considerable success. Our Basenjis have won many All Breeds in Show awards including Best in Show, Best Opposite Sex in Show and Runner Up in Show, and Basenji Specialty Shows and Royal Challenges. In 1974 we imported two Basenjis from England, one being "Aust Ch Domewood The Artful Dodger" who became the first Basenji to win Best in Show at an All Breeds Championship Show in Victoria. After 37 years in the breed, we decided to give up breeding and showing as my husband was having health problems, and he passed away in 2008.

I have served as Secretary and Show Secretary to the Basenji Club of NSW for many years and in 2013, in company with John Forbes, the Club honoured us both with Life Memberships which were presented by Life Member, Alan Hunt,

I am delighted to be a part of your Club's 50th Anniversary celebrations and hope that it will continue to prosper over the many years to come. While my husband concentrated more on the stewarding and administrative side of the dog world, I was active in the showing, breeding and judging arenas. In 1979 I obtained my first Group judging licence – the Hound Group - and am now licensed to judge All Breeds at Championship Show level. Over the years, I have judged in England, Finland, Germany, USA, South Africa, Thailand, New Zealand and in all States of Australia. I have judged Basenji Specialties in England, Finland and the USA (including their National Specialty) and have also judged Hound Specialties in New Zealand and every State and Territory in Australia.

I am a Life Member of the Basenji Club of Victoria and also the Hound Club of Victoria.

I feel very honoured and privileged to be invited to judge at the Basenji Club of Victoria's 2016 Championship Show during the Club's 50th year anniversary year. Especially as it is being held in memory of John Forbes (Baagna Basenjis), who was a keen supporter of our Club.

- The Basenji Breed Standard

GENERAL APPEARANCE: Lightly built, finely boned aristocratic-looking animal, high on leg compared with its length, always poised, alert and intelligent. Wrinkled head, with pricked ears, proudly carried on a well-arched neck. Deep brisket runs up into a definite waist, tail tightly curled presenting a picture of a well-balanced dog of gazelle-like grace.

CHARACTERISTICS: Barkless but not mute, its own special noise of mixture of a chortle and a yodel. Remarkable for its cleanliness in every way.

TEMPERAMENT: An intelligent, independent, but affectionate and alert breed. Can be aloof with strangers.

HEAD AND SKULL: Flat, well-chiselled and medium width, tapering towards nose, with slight stop. Distance from top of head to stop slightly more than from stop to tip of nose. Side lines of skull taper gradually towards mouth, giving a clean-cheeked appearance. Fine and profuse wrinkles appearing on forehead when ears pricked, side wrinkles desirable but not exaggerated into dewlap. Wrinkles more noticeable in puppies, but because of lack of shadowing, not as noticeable in tri-colours. Black nose desirable.

EYES: Dark, almond-shaped, obliquely set, far-seeing and rather inscrutable in expression.

EARS: Small, pointed, erect and slightly hooded, of fine texture, set well forward on top of head, tip of ear nearer centre of skull than outside base.

MOUTH: Jaws strong, with perfect, regular and complete scissor bite, i.e. Upper teeth closely overlapping lower teeth and set square to the jaws.

NECK: Strong and of good length, without thickness, well crested and slightly full at base of throat with a graceful curve accentuating crest. Well-set into shoulders giving head a "lofty" carriage. FOREQUARTERS: Shoulders well laid back, muscular, not loaded. Elbows tucked in against bris-

ket. When viewed from front, elbows in line with ribs and legs should continue in a straight line to ground giving a medium front. Forelegs straight with fine bone and very long fore-arms. Pasterns good length, straight and flexible.

BODY: Balanced with short, level back. Ribs well sprung, deep and oval. Loin short coupled, deep brisket running up into definite waist.

HINDQUARTERS: Strong and muscular, hocks well let down, turned neither in nor out, with long second thighs and moderately bent stifles.

FEET: Small, narrow and compact, with deep pads, well arched toes and short nails.

TAIL: High set, with posterior curve of buttock extending beyond root of tail giving a reachy appearance to hindquarters. Curls tightly over spine and lies closely to thigh with a single or double curl.

GAIT/MOVEMENT: Legs carried straight forward with a swift long tireless swinging stride. COAT: Short, sleek and close, very fine. Skin very pliant.

COLOUR: Pure black and white; red and white; black tan and white with tan melon pips and mask; black, tan and white. Brindle, red background with black stripes, the more clearly defined the stripes the better. The white should be on feet, chest and tail tip. White legs, blaze and white collar optional.

SIZE: Ideal height: Dogs 43 cm (17 ins) at withers Bitches 40 cm (16 ins) at withers Ideal weight: Dogs 11 kg (24 lbs) Bitches 9.5 kg (21 lbs)

FAULTS: Any departure from the foregoing points should be considered a fault and the seriousness with which the fault should be regarded should be in exact proportion to its degree.

NOTE: Male animals should have two apparently normal testicles fully descended into the scrotum.

Lil's devotion to dogs began long before her interest in Basenjis. In 1940, her husband, Keith, enlisted in the R.A.A.F. and for protection, Lil purchased a German shepherd. It was at this time that Lil's interest in the show ring began. Although the German shepherd was moderately successful, she had her first taste of the big prizes when, after years of breeding, she exhibited a German shepherd which gained Best Puppy in Group and Best Bitch in Group at the 1955 Melbourne Royal Show. Other breeds exhibited by Lil were Corgis, Dobermans and Poodles. It was in 1963 that she became interested in Basenjis when she imported Sheldon Red Rolf from New Zealand. Typical of many Basenji owners, Lil became very enthusiastic about the breed, and in 1964 imported "Portia of Clendon" from New Zealand.

stitution. This did not stop Lil. A few weeks later, after several trips to the K.C.C., she rang me to say that the K.C.C. had given her permission to form a club.

My first encounter with Lil and Portia was in 1965 when they defeated my bitch for Best Basenji Bitch at the Royal Sydney Show. A few months later, my wife and I returned to Melbourne. It was at this time we became friendly with Lil, her family and her dogs. As near as I can recall, it was March 1966 when Lil began talking about the formation of a club. She approached me and asked my advice on how to begin. I was a little apprehensive at the time because we lacked the numbers to form a quorum as required by the Kennel Control Council Con-

The inaugural meeting was held in July 1966 at Dr. White's residence in South Yarra. If I had any doubts before arriving, they were dismissed very quickly on entering Dr. White's home. I'll never know how she did it, but there were Basenji owners from everywhere. People I did not know existed, and of course, registered with the K.C.C. as Junior Members were her children, Phil, Carol and Adrian. We made that quorum!!! It was through actions like these that we saw the birth of the Basenji Club of Victoria. Lil then carried the Presidency for the first two years. I doubt if everyone who is a member of the B.C.O.V., or Associate Basenji Clubs realizes that, in some way, they are indebted to Lil for her far sighted actions.

This club has grown to be one of the best and most respected in dogdom in its ten short years. Lil, to you from every Basenji fancier, we extend our thanks for what you have given us.
